1. This grant must be used during the 2010-2011 academic year.
2. The funded project must be executed as proposed.
3. This grant MAY NOT be used for scholarships or tuition.
4. Only one proposal may be submitted in any academic year.
5. Matching resources provided by the school may be in money and/or in-kind contributions.
6. The applying SAI chapter must be in "good standing" with the fraternity.
7. The application must be prepared jointly by the Sigma Alpha Iota chapter president and the music department head or another authorized official.
8. Selection will be made on the following basis:
 - Potential impact of project on the larger musical community.
 - Feasibility as outlined in the application
 - Originality
9. The original application, budget, and signature page (**plus four copies of each**) must be mailed to National Headquarters.
