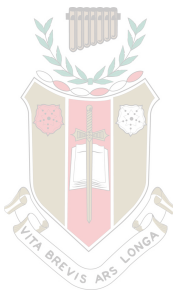


Incorporation Day

What is Incorporation Day?

It is the day Sigma Alpha Iota was duly incorporated as a nonprofit association under the laws of the State of Michigan.

This took place on:
December 15, 1904



Who prepared the documentation?

Ann Arbor attorney, Carl Storm, along with the Committee on Laws and Rules prepared the Articles of Association.

Appointed to this committee, at the initial meeting on June 12, 1903 were:

Elizabeth Campbell, chairman

Leila Farlin

Frances Caspari



Document Signing

The Document was signed on:
December 1, 1904

Nine members of Alpha Chapter were present:

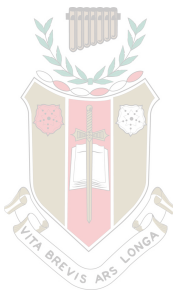
- Five Founders, still present at the University
