## Pledging Ceremony

Pledging Ceremonies are **not** to be referred to as:

- Pinning
- Pinning Ceremonies
- Pin-in

\*Note – MITs are no longer called pledges but we still refer to the ceremony as a pledging ceremony because it is when they pledge themselves to become members of our fraternity.



#### Initiation

All initiation ceremonies should be referred to in the same manner, as initiation.

#### They are **not**:

- Crossing
- Crossing over
- Induction

- Pledges
- Roses
- Rose buds
