

WEARING THE SIGMA ALPHA IOTA BADGE

Badge attire, casual attire, placement, and
more!

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THE BASICS...

- **Our Sigma Alpha Iota badge is placed on the left side, over the heart.** It is always attached to dresses or blouses. Never place the badge on suit jackets or coats, *unless the jacket will not be removed*. Recognition insignia may be worn on a suit lapel or coat collar or lapel as a sign of fraternity membership when the badge cannot be seen.
- The regulation badge should never be turned into a charm.
- A guard may be attached to the badge with a short chain and pinned below and to one side of the badge.



WHAT IF I AM A MEMBER OF TWO ORGANIZATIONS?

If the badge of another fraternity is also worn, it may be chained to the Sigma Alpha Iota badge or be kept separate—it should not be worn above it. The two badges may be worn at the same level beside each other.

Recognition Pins!

This jewelry is worn when the official badge is not appropriate (e.g. with casual clothing including jeans, on lapels or caps, etc.). There are three styles of recognition pins (stick pin, large and small) with the letters “Sigma,” “Alpha,” “Iota.”

WEARING THE SAI BADGE: A PRIVILEGE OF MEMBERSHIP



- The regulation badge should only be worn with appropriate, professional attire.
- The badge is worn as a direct representation of Sigma Alpha Iota.

BADGE ATTIRE- WHAT TO WEAR!

We wear badge attire for formal meetings and ritual ceremonies, attending Initiation as a guest, Province Day, concerts, or special events. These are examples of professional, business, or casual business dress- appropriate to wear with our SAI badge.

THE SPECIAL OCCASION: GOWNS OR FORMAL WEAR



- Wearing your badge with a gown or other formal wear is optional.
- The badge should not be worn with a strapless or spaghetti strap gown.

OUR BADGE.... ADDITIONAL FACTS!



- Alumnae members may not donate their badge to a MIT.
- A chapter must have the MIT's badges to conduct initiation.
- Province Day is a badge attire occasion!
- Herff Jones, our official jeweler, can repair your badge if an issue should arise. Contact NH for specific directions.
- A member has a life leasehold on her badge until she dies or is expelled from the Fraternity.
- The badge of a deceased member, including all attached honors, should be returned to National Headquarters. It will be placed in the Memorial Collection and held there in trust so that it can be given to a descendant who is initiated into Sigma Alpha Iota in the future. The badge of a deceased member will not be resold.
- If a member is expelled from the Fraternity, she must return her badge and all official SAI insignia to National Headquarters.
