## SAI National Convention Volunteer Opportunities

**Volunteer Greeter**: About 10 individuals are needed to work half a day only for the short period of time when volunteer shifts change to direct people where to go to perform their job and explain any instructions needed. These individuals, once they have confirmed everyone is where they are needed to be and all crucial positions are filled, are then free to attend convention events and workshops.

**Registration Set Up**: About 5-8 individuals are needed on July 27 (*this is one day BEFORE convention*) to assemble and stuff all of the registration materials that will be passed out to all attendees.

**Registration**: Several individuals will be needed to help register attendees and work directly with the registration team leader on 7/28, 7/29 and 7/30. Each registration work shift will be 3 hours.

**Set-Up Crew**: about 20-30 individuals are needed to set up everything from chapter place cards on the general assembly tables to province flags, map of the chapters and assist with fraternity displays. You must be able bodied and able to lift things. *All set up takes place the morning of July 26th* and is completed by the first official event of convention in the early evening.

**Ritual Set up**: 5-10 individuals are needed to work directly with NVPR Tracey Wygal-Withrow to set up ritual. This includes ironing robes and drapes as well as taking passwords at the start of convention. You must be available early in the day on 7/28.

**Convention Floor Page**: For each General Session about 6-10 individuals are needed to monitor the assembly floor and assist delegates with any needs so they can devote 100% of their attention to the business meeting at hand. This includes running correspondence between delegates and with the NEB. Pages wear a sash on the floor so they are easily recognizable to the delegates. Each page will be scheduled for one general session which is usually 2-3 hours in length.

**Concert Usher**: In addition to performances throughout the general sessions there will also be programmed concerts at various performance venues in the hotel. Ushers will need to arrive before the doors open to attendees, pass out programs and assist people to their seats.

**Phlea-Phlam Set Up:** 4 individuals are needed to work directly with the Phlea-Phlam team leader early in the morning of July 30<sup>th</sup> to set up tables and assist chapters with set up. Phlea-Phlam is scheduled to begin at 8am.

**Display Room Monitor:** One or two individuals are needed to monitor the philanthropy displays when the room is open to ensure the well-being of those displays and assist people in the room. Each shift will be 2-3 hours throughout all 5 days of convention.

**Decorations:** 3-4 individuals are needed to help put together centerpieces for the welcome luncheon as well as Dinner of Honors.

**Tear Down Team:** About 20-30 individuals will be needed on Monday August 1st after the close of convention. Everything will need to be taken down and packed up to return to Asheville! Perfect for someone that has a late flight or is leaving the day after convention.
