Important Information for Collegiate Delegates!

IT IS THE OBLIGATION OF ALL CHAPTERS TO HAVE A DELEGATE IN ATTENDANCE AT NATIONAL CONVENTION! Please contact the NVPC and NVPF with any problems related to attendance.

The collegiate chapter delegate registration will be processed as follows:

Each year a collegiate chapter is assessed a \$250 convention fund fee; when that is paid it is set aside as a “savings account” to be used by the chapter for convention. When the delegate registers for convention the registration fee (**\$385 if early-bird, \$435 after May 31st**) will be paid for out of money the chapter has paid into the convention fund. The remainder that is left in the convention fund will be sent to the chapter to help defray delegate expenses. The chapter is expected to reimburse their delegate for travel, hotel, and reasonable meal costs.

Example: Chapter has paid into their convention savings

2020-21	125.00
2021-22	125.00
Total paid	<u>750.00</u>
Early bird registration	<u>-385.00</u>
Remainder (chapter will receive this amount)	\$365.00
