Travel

Airport: Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport (MSP) (20 minutes to/from hotel)

Transportation to/from hotel: Light rail, shuttle, taxi, rideshare (currently around \$60 for Uber)

Train: Amtrak (Drops off 20 minutes to/from the hotel)

Hotel Parking: Valet (\$49/day) and self-parking (\$25/day or \$30/day for in-and-out privileges) - always confirm on hotel website

Note: Anyone flying should have a Real ID or passport



Collegiate Chapters - Convention Fund

If all three years of convention fund payments have been made to NH:

- Collegiate chapter delegate should register online (no payment needed).
- After the delegate has registered <u>AND</u> the signed delegate agreement form has been received at NH, funds leftover after the registration payment of \$445 will be returned to the chapter to assist in covering other expenses of the chapter's delegate and/or general attendees (if early-bird registration and no patron concert ticket upgrade selected).

Collegiate chapters installed or re-activated during the triennium will slightly vary, depending on the amount paid into the Convention Fund. These chapters will be contacted by the NVP Finance with financial specifics.

Arrival

Arrive on Thursday, July 17 prior to: 12 PM (Minneapolis is in Central Time, so you may need to coordinate with your time zone)

If you are a non-delegate: Arrive before 3 PM Central Time.

If elected to a Regional or Province Officer position, you will attend a meeting on Monday morning.

Those elected to the NEB will stay through 12 p.m. CT on Tuesday, July 22.

Departure

Don't plan to leave until Mon., July 21 after 3 PM CT.







